Boarding Do's and Don'ts

We want your pet's stay with us to be as comfortable as possible. There are a few items that we encourage you to bring and a few that we provide. We encourage instruction lists. It helps us out a lot when going over how to take care of your pet while they stay with us.

The only item we require is vaccine history or access to your pet's vaccine history if your pet has not been with us before. Please call if you have any questions or concerns.

Things to bring:

- Toys
- Treats
- Medications (if applicable):
 - Please keep medications in original containers, especially if they are from a different clinic/hospital, so that staff may identify the medication.
 - In the event medications have been moved to a secondary container, please provide a list of medications your pet is taking.
- Food:
 - Please bring any dietary specific foods: example: liver, kidney, allergy
 - Wet food
 - We cannot feed raw diets at our facility. (no raw beef/chicken)
 - Refrigerated foods are okay (Rachel ray, etc)
 - It is recommended to bring prebagged dry food or small containers, but not required.

Provided by Kleinpeter Veterinary Hospital:

- Bedding:
 - Blankets of all shapes, sizes, colors
 - Kurunda bed for our runs: a cot-like bed that is low to the ground
- Bowls:
 - Many shapes, colors and sizes.
 - We do not have slow feeder bowls, please let us know if this is a special requirement of your pet.
- Food:
 - Purina Veterinary diet EN: Gastroenteric: a chicken and rice diet
 - Fed to all pets as a maintenance feed when no food is provided, no additional charge.

Please let us know of any special requirements your pet may have: anxiety, aggression towards other unknown pets, extra yard time, etc. In the event a medication or food is needed, please discuss with a receptionist. We may be able to fill some of it for you. If you are a new client/patient for us, an examination may be required prior to medications being filled.
